## The Roles...

#### 1. Nurse Manager

Reporting to the Head of Clinical Services, supported by the Director of Nursing through a matrix management approach, the Nurse Manager will work collaboratively as part of clinical services team to:

- Provide highly visible clinical professional leadership of Totara Hospice's nursing workforce across In-Patient and Community Services, to ensure the most efficient, effective and appropriate nursing services are provided to Totara Hospice's patients and families within our model of care and resource parameters
- The Nurse Manager will also work collaboratively as part of the Clinical Services team implementing operating integrated work plans, and ensuring accountabilities, projects and programmes are informed by best practice and are outcomes based.

# 2. Team Leader Community Nursing

Reporting to the Nurse Manager, the Team Leader Community Nursing will work

- To provide effective leadership and support to the community, day hospice and outpatient palliative care services.
- To ensure optimum clinical palliative care is provided to all patients and families/whanau through management of the systems, processes and resources within the community and ambulatory services.
- To ensure collaborative engagement with the Totara Hospice clinical team and the primary health care and hospital based teams.
- Work collaboratively as part of the clinical services team and ensure operating integrated work plans, accountabilities, projects and programmes are informed by best practice and are outcomes based.

# 3. IPU Charge Nurse

Reporting to the Nurse Manager, the IPU Charge Nurse will work

- To ensure optimum clinical palliative care is provided to all patients and families/whanau through management of the systems, processes and resources within the Inpatient service.
- To provide effective leadership and support to the in-patient unit palliative care nursing team.





- To ensure collaborative engagement with the Totara Hospice clinical team and the primary health care and hospital based teams.
- Work collaboratively as part of the clinical services team ensure operating integrated work plans, accountabilities, projects and programmes are informed by best practice and are outcomes based.

## To be successful in these roles you will/must have:

#### Nurse Manager

- Extensive experience in the management of administration and clinical management of a multidisciplinary team
- Experience in budgeting and operational planning, monitoring and review processes.
- Experience as a nurse in a palliative care, medical, surgical or aged care setting.
- A post graduate qualification in health management or business management would be desirable, so would experience in a Hospice setting.

Team Leader Community Nursing & IPU Charge Nurse

- Registered Nurse with a current APC
- Post graduate qualification in Palliative Care with clinical experience in palliative care nursing, community or medical nursing
- Experience of leadership of nursing staff and up-to-date with current Palliative Care knowledge
- Previous clinical nursing experience in supervision and preceptoring/coaching/mentoring newly qualified nurses and/or students
- Tertiary Education applicable to the position e.g. Preceptor or Adult Education Training would be desirable as would previous experience in working in a multi-disciplinary team environment with the knowledge of the principals of budget and NGO principals
